

Swachh Bharat Abhiyan is long cleanliness campaign launched by the Government of India on 2nd October 2014. The campaign was aimed to make streets, roads and offices clean from filth and garbage.

The prime objective of the drive is to make India Open Defecation Free. The campaign also targets raising public awareness on the importance of cleanliness through rigorous media campaigns and to institute door to door garbage collection and its safe disposal.

Objectives of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan

- Improving the quality of life in rural areas through cleanliness and personal hygiene.
- To make India free of open defecation within five years, till 2nd October 2019.
- To construct 90 million toilets in rural areas at an estimated cost of Rs 1.96 lakh crore.
- To encourage private sectors for making capital expenditure in the project or into the operational and maintenance cost.
- · To convert unsanitary toilets into the toilets with flush.
- · Create awareness among communities towards sanitation and cleanliness.
- To bring about behavioral changes in the people towards sanitation and hygiene.
- Motivating the communities for adopting a proper sanitation model for better health and life.
- To tell people how sanitation is linked to their overall health and happiness.

 To encourage and acknowledge new technological innovation in the field of sanitation or cleanliness.

- To rope in proper support from eminent personalities and notable public figures to raise awareness among the people.
- To devise a proper, door to door, waste collection and disposal system, both in villages as well as urban areas.
- To make necessary changes in the local bodies in order to strengthen their functions and efficiency.
- To ensure proper availability of water in rural areas through a network of pipes.
- To construct separate toilets for boys and girls in all the schools throughout the country.
- To provide clean drinking water in all the schools and also to ensure availability of toiletries like soap etc.

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

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






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
