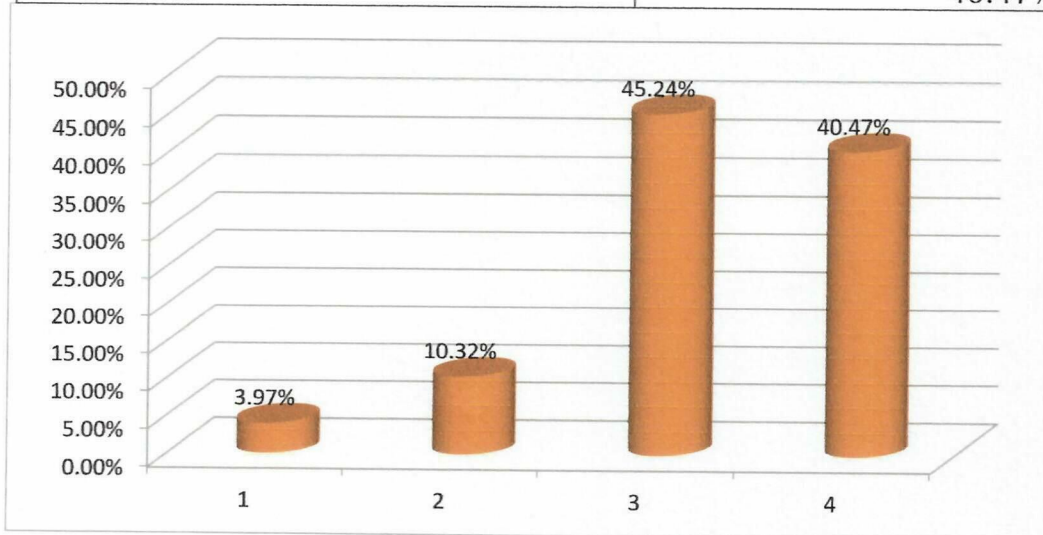

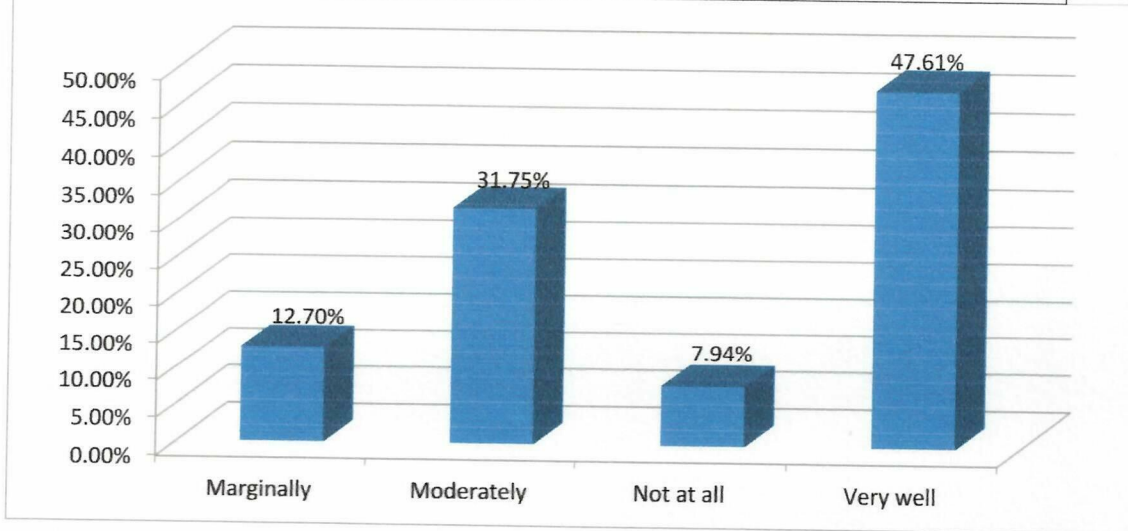
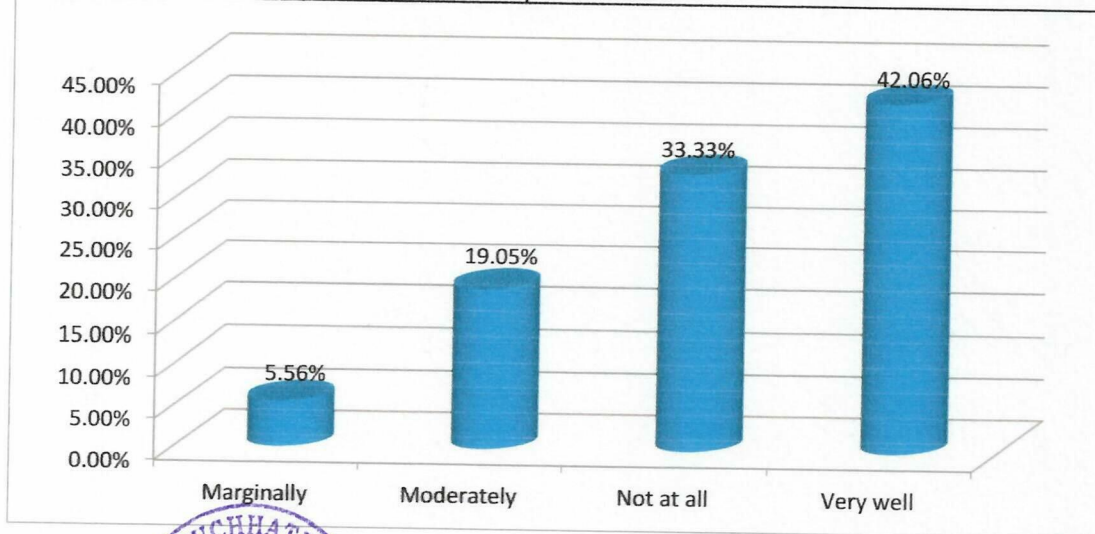


Table No4. Do you think the curriculum teaches your employability skills?

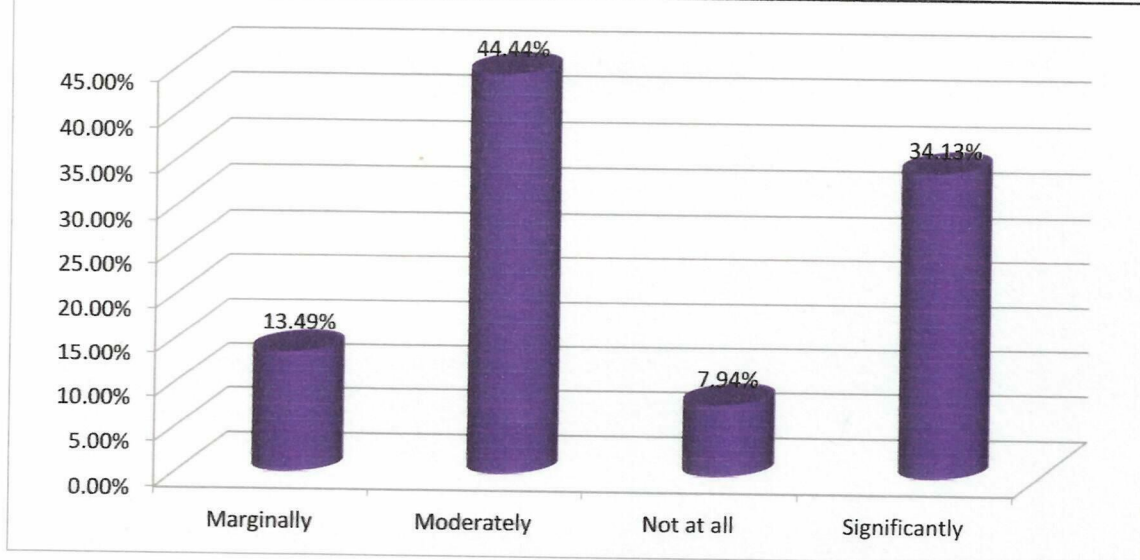
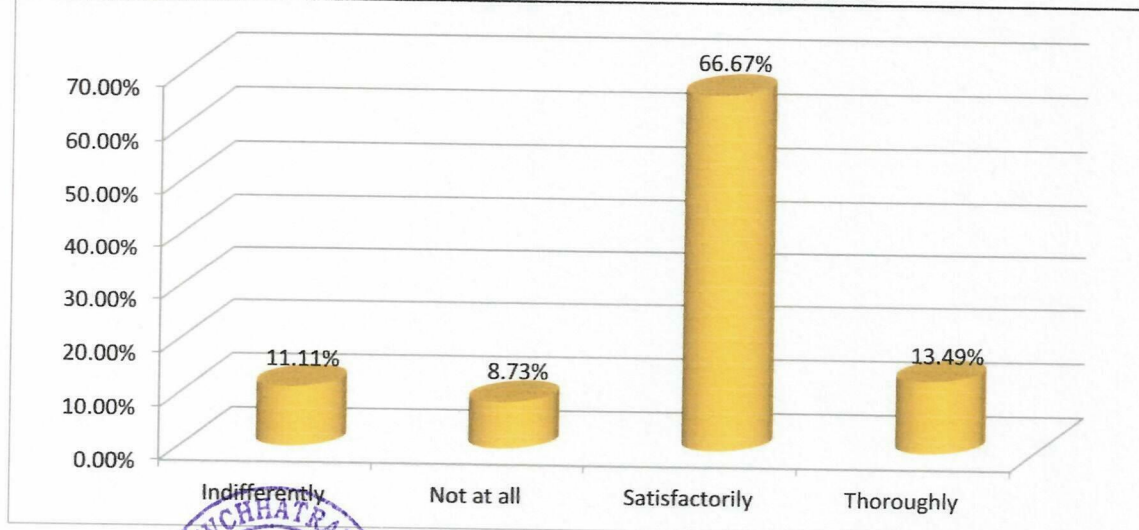


Table no 6. How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?

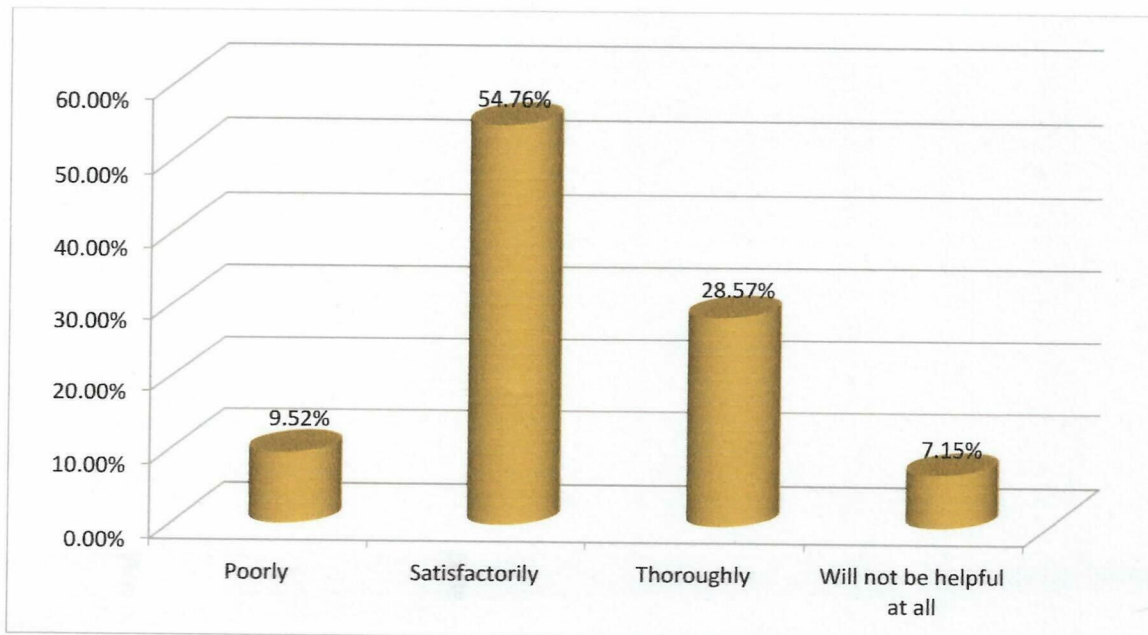
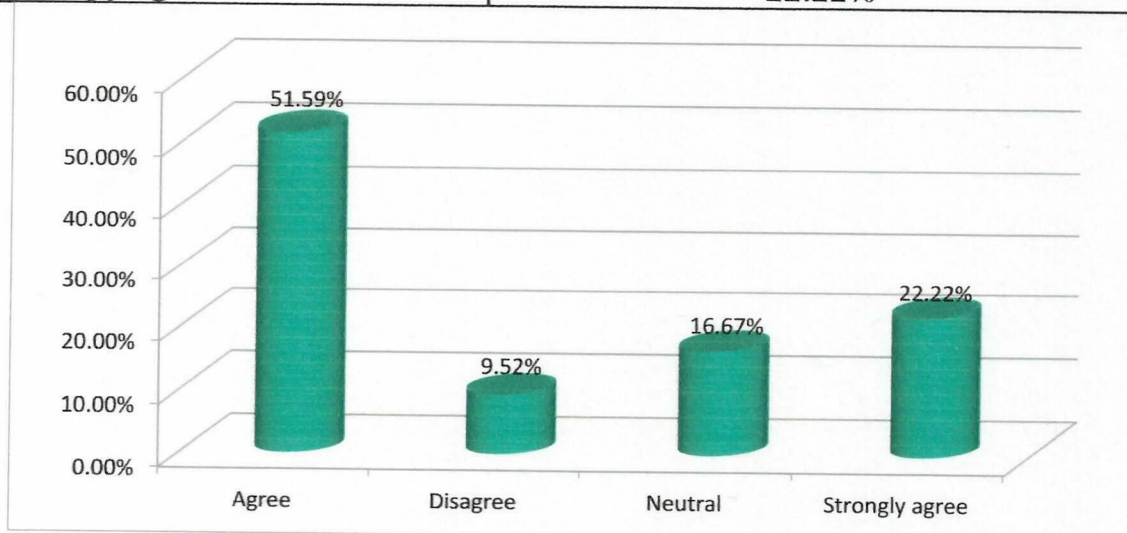


Table no. 8. The curriculum encouraged for research in your subject.

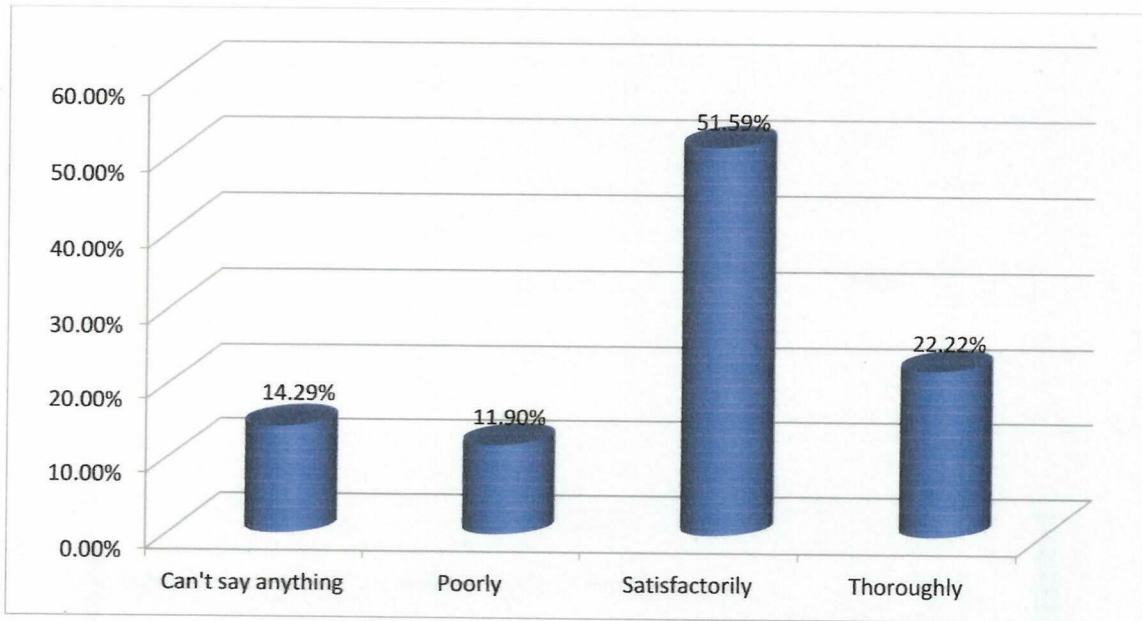

47.61% of the students feel that they are well prepared for job readiness after completion of the program / course. Around 30% of the respondents feel that they are moderately ready after completion of the course/ program.

Around 40% of the respondents feel that the curriculum teaches them employment skills very well.

5. To how much curriculum fulfilled your learning needs?

Around 45% of the students feel that the curriculum fulfills the learning needs of the learners moderately. Around 35% of the respondents feel that the curriculum fulfills their need to significant level.
