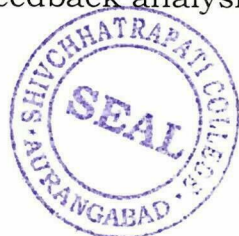

Report of Analysis of Survey on Attainment of POs and COs

A) The context: The Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Shivchhatrapati Program Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs). A questionnaire was circulated among the students. The feedback responses were collected from the students studying in the different classes in the academic year 2021-22. The feedback was taken on the following aspects:

- ❖ Curriculum and its significance.
- ❖ Syllabus match your expectations
- ❖ How do you think that you are ready for job in market after completing the course / program?
- ❖ Do you think the curriculum teaches your employability skills?
- ❖ How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?
- ❖ How do you think the practical work/field work in prescribed in the curriculum will be helpful in your future life?
- ❖ The curriculum encouraged for research in your subject
- ❖ Do you think you are job ready/ready for higher studies/ research activity?

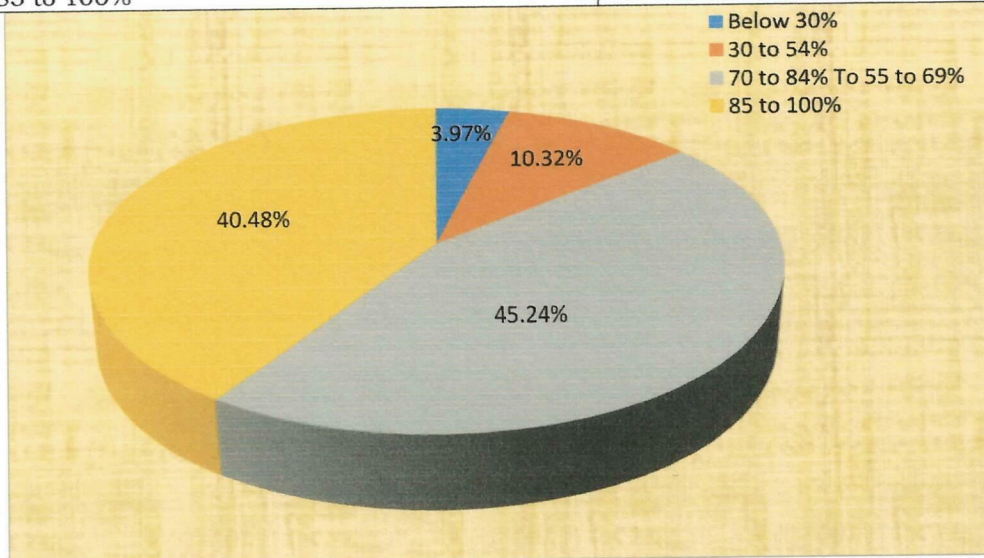
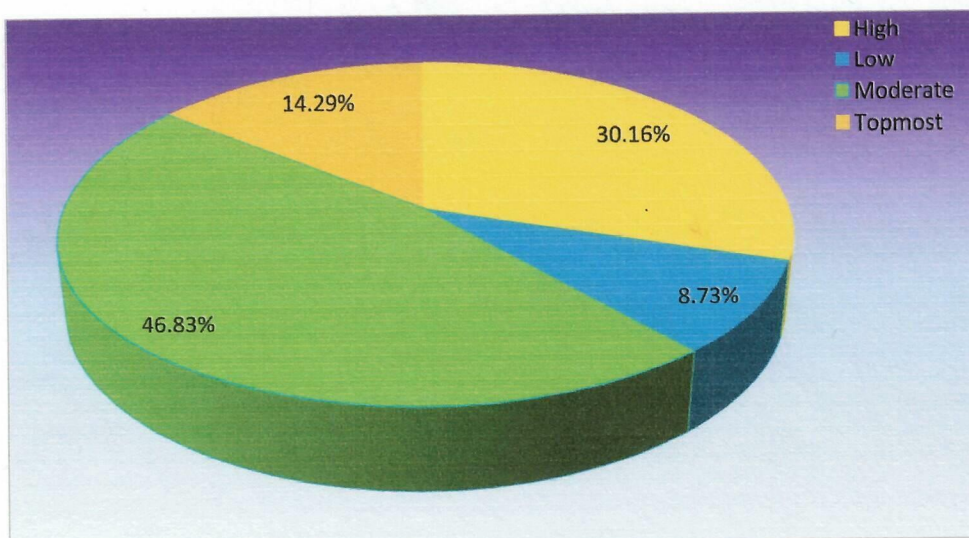

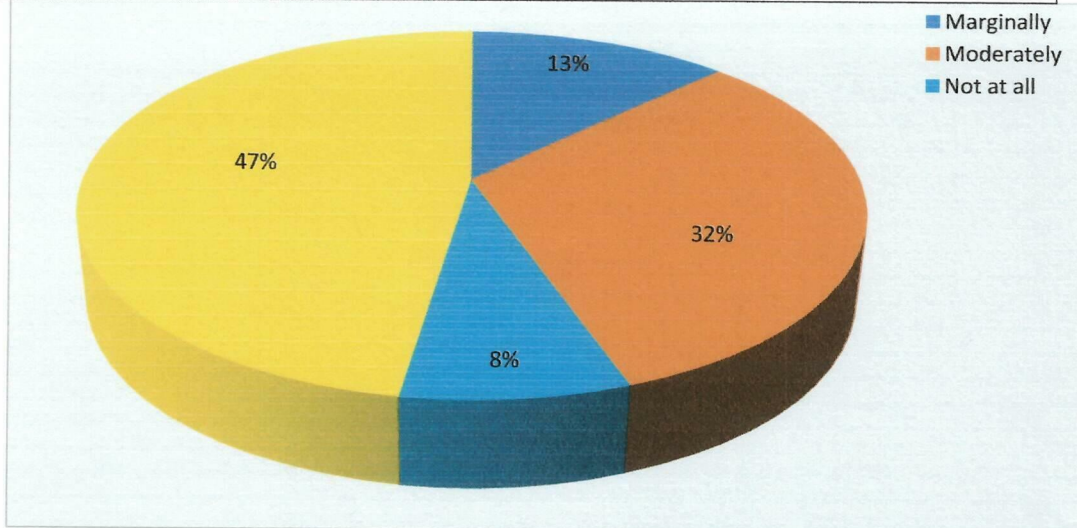
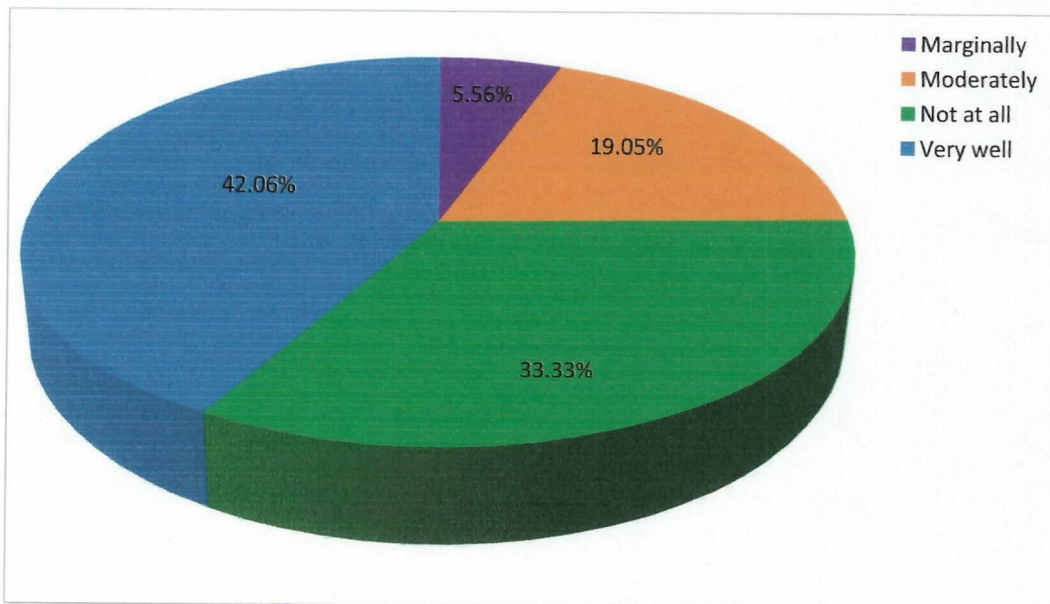


Table No 4. Do you think the curriculum teaches your employability skills?

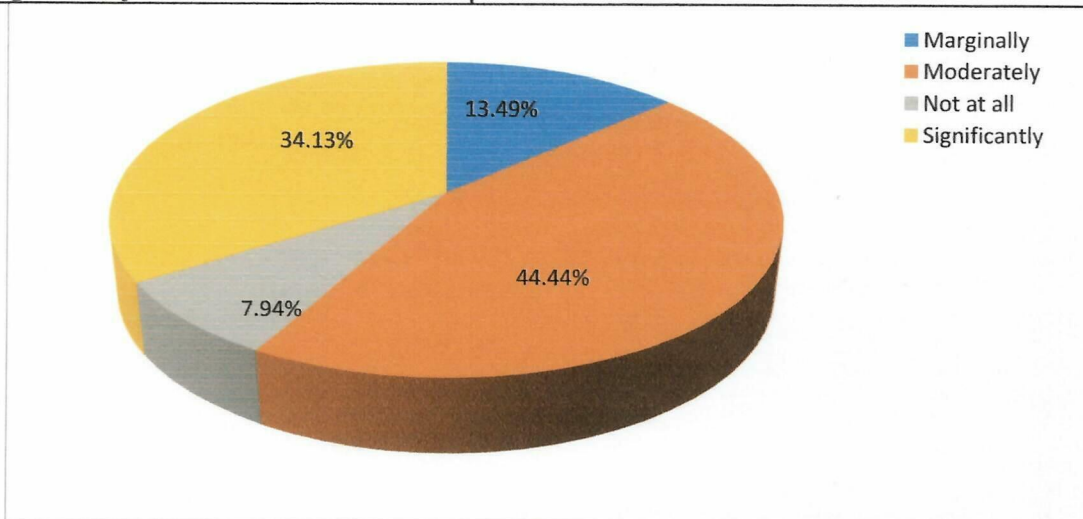
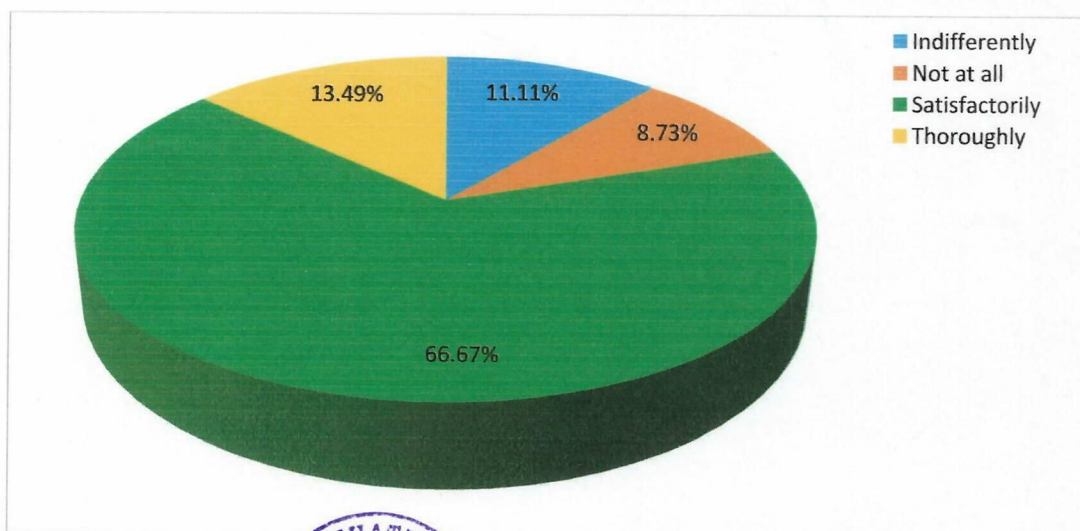


Table no 6. How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?

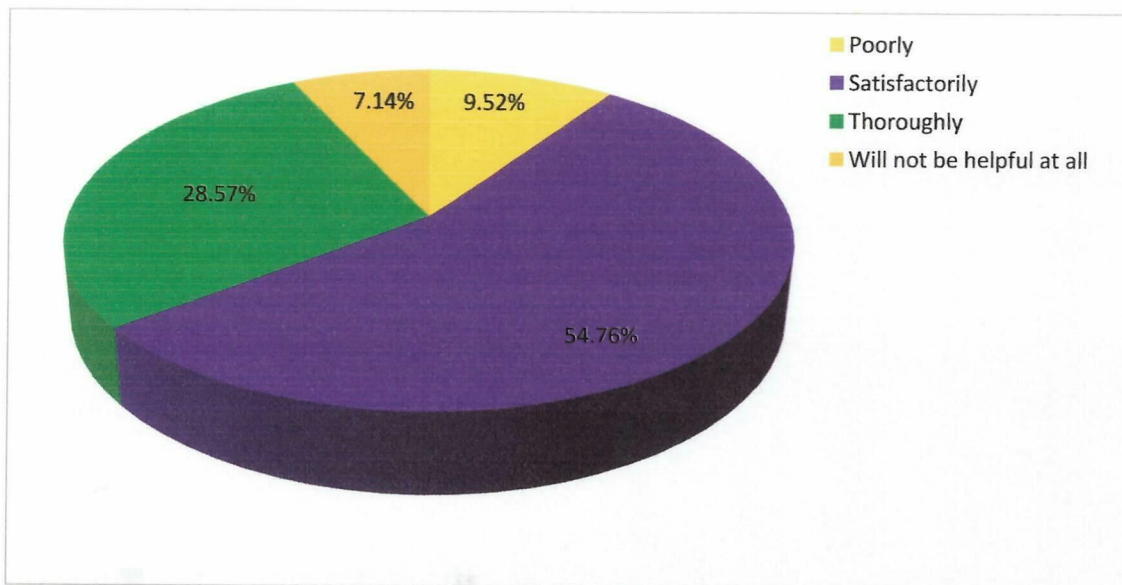
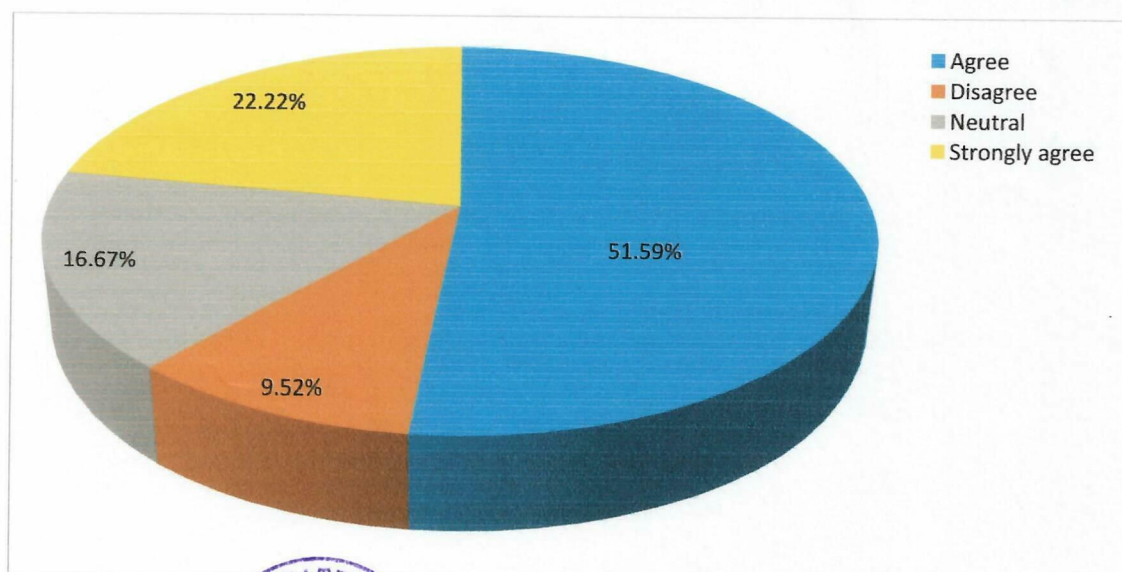


Table no. 8. The curriculum encouraged for research in your subject.

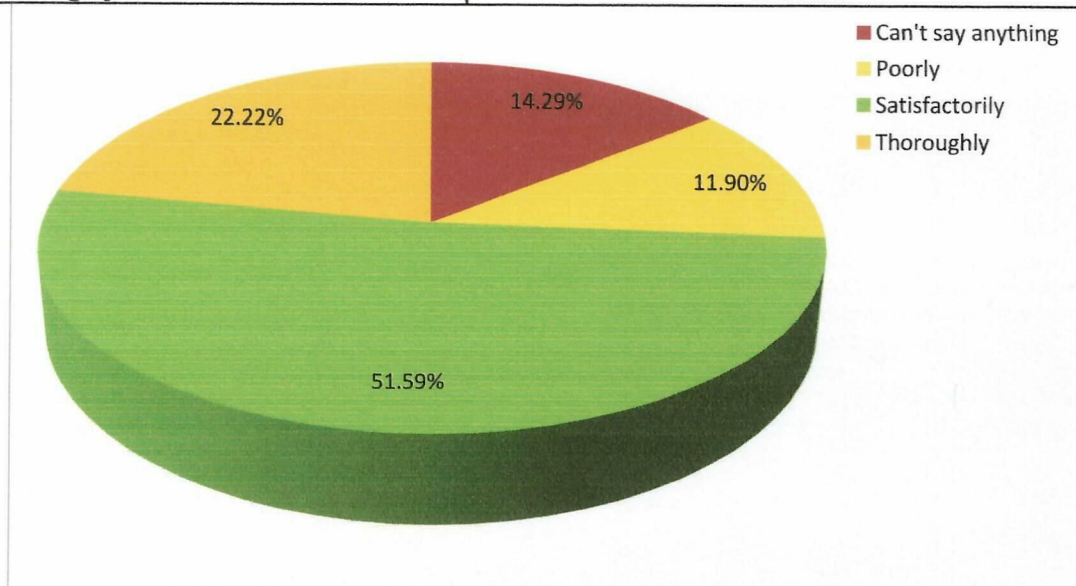

C) Discussion and conclusion on the Students Feedback on Curriculum:

1. How much do you think you understood your curriculum and its significance?

Out of 126 respondents who participated in the survey, 40.48% students agreed that they understood 85 to 100% the syllabus understood, while 45.24% students responded as 70 to 84%. The remaining students like this: 10.32 voted for 30 to 54% and 3.97% students' respondent below 30% has been understand the syllabus.

2. How did the syllabus match your expectations?

The feedback on the curriculum's ability to match your expectations is as follows: Students believe that the syllabus meets expectations are high, 30%. students believe it is moderate 46, 14 students believe it is topmost, 8 students believe that syllabus match your expectations are low.

3. How do you think that you are ready for job in market after completing the course / program?

When the students were asked to give an answer for this aspect, 126 students said that the ready for job in market after completing the course / programs very well next, 47.62 respond with moderately 31 followed by 12 students with marginally, 7 with Not at all.




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4. Do you think the curriculum teaches your employability skills?

Among the 126 students, 42.06% students are of opinion that curriculum teaches employability skill is very well. 19.05% students believe in moderately, 19.05 % students vote to marginally and 33.33% students goes to fair of not fulfill employability skills.

5. To how much curriculum fulfilled your learning needs?

44.44% learners said the curriculum fulfill their learning needs moderately; 13.49 % students rated it marginally. 34.13% students were significantly learning needs and the remaining 7.94% students believe that fair to Not at all.

6. How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?

One of the questions in the survey is regarding objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled. The responses to this are as follows: 66.67% students are satisfactorily, 81.49% students fair to thoroughly, 11.11% students are believed indifferently, 8.73% students are to vote not at all.

7. How do you think the practical work/field work in prescribed in the curriculum will be helpful in your future life?

The shares for this aspect are: 28.57 % students responded the question as thoroughly; 9.52% students are fair to poorly; 7.14% students believe that Won't be helpful at all.

8. The curriculum encouraged for research in your subject.

The opinion regarding to curriculum encouraged for research in your subject are as follow, 51.59% students are agreed, 22.22% students are strongly agreed, 16.67% students vote to neutral and 9.52% students are disagreed.

9. Do you think you are job ready/ready for higher studies/ research activity?


