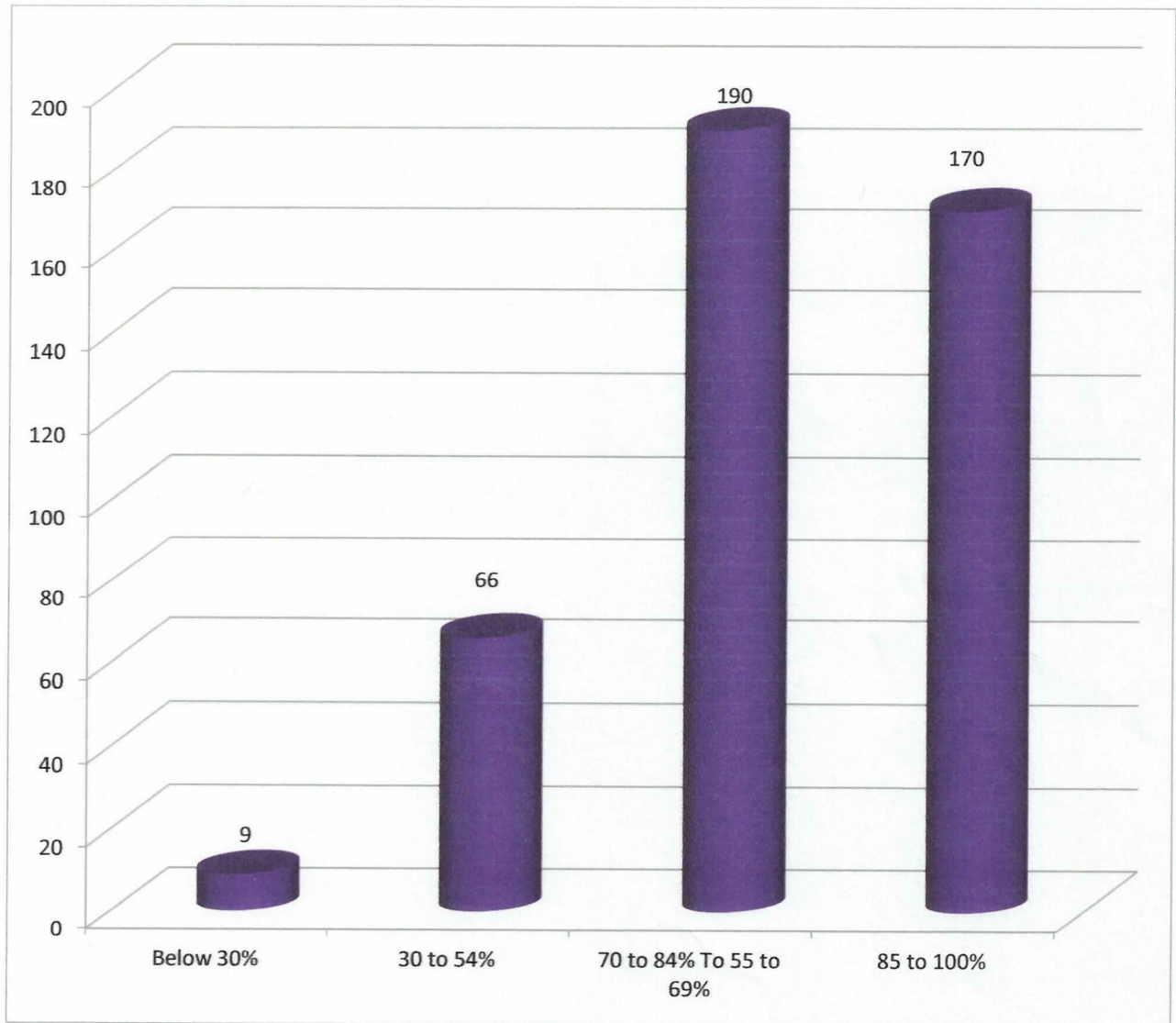

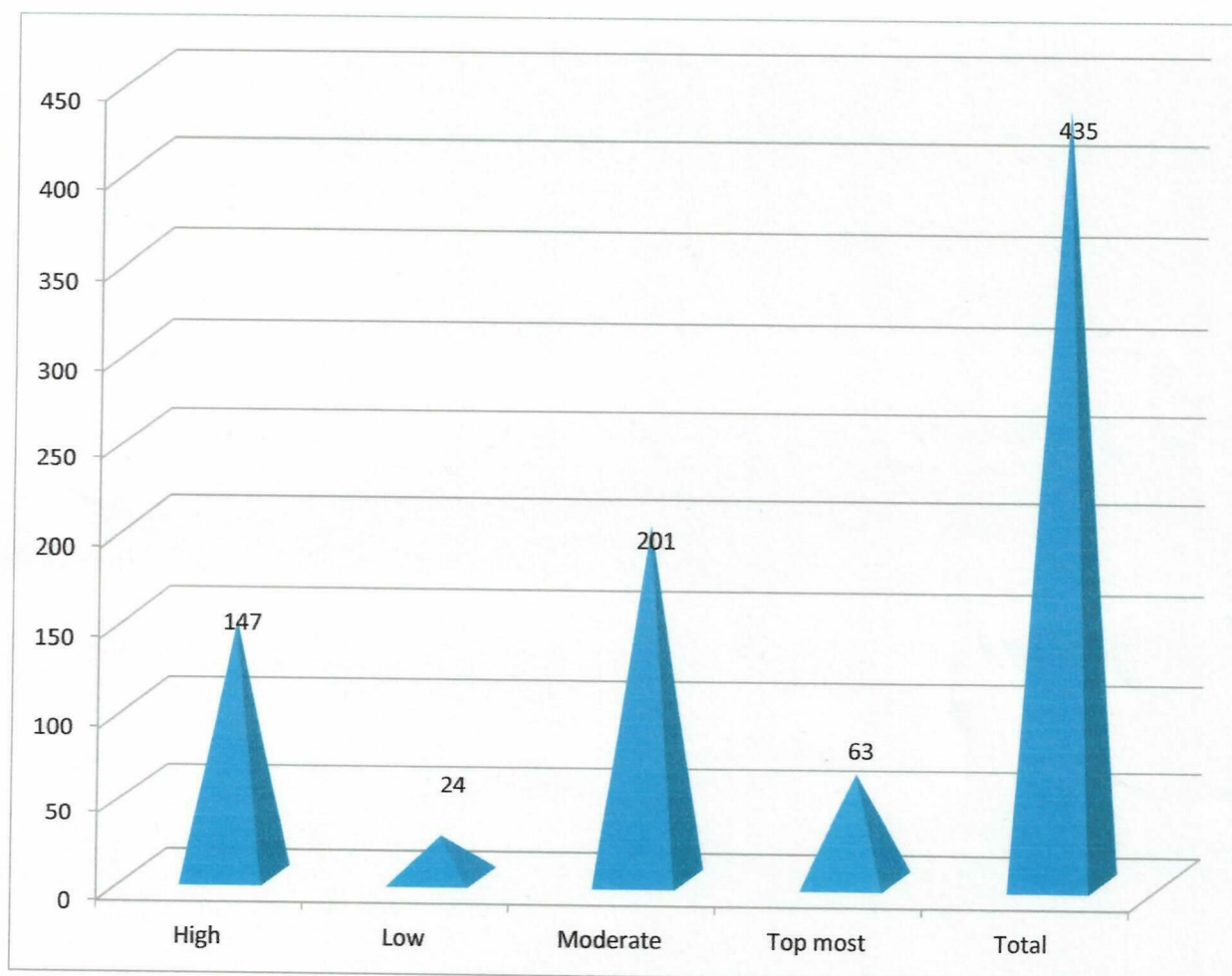

Table No 2. How did the syllabus match your expectations?

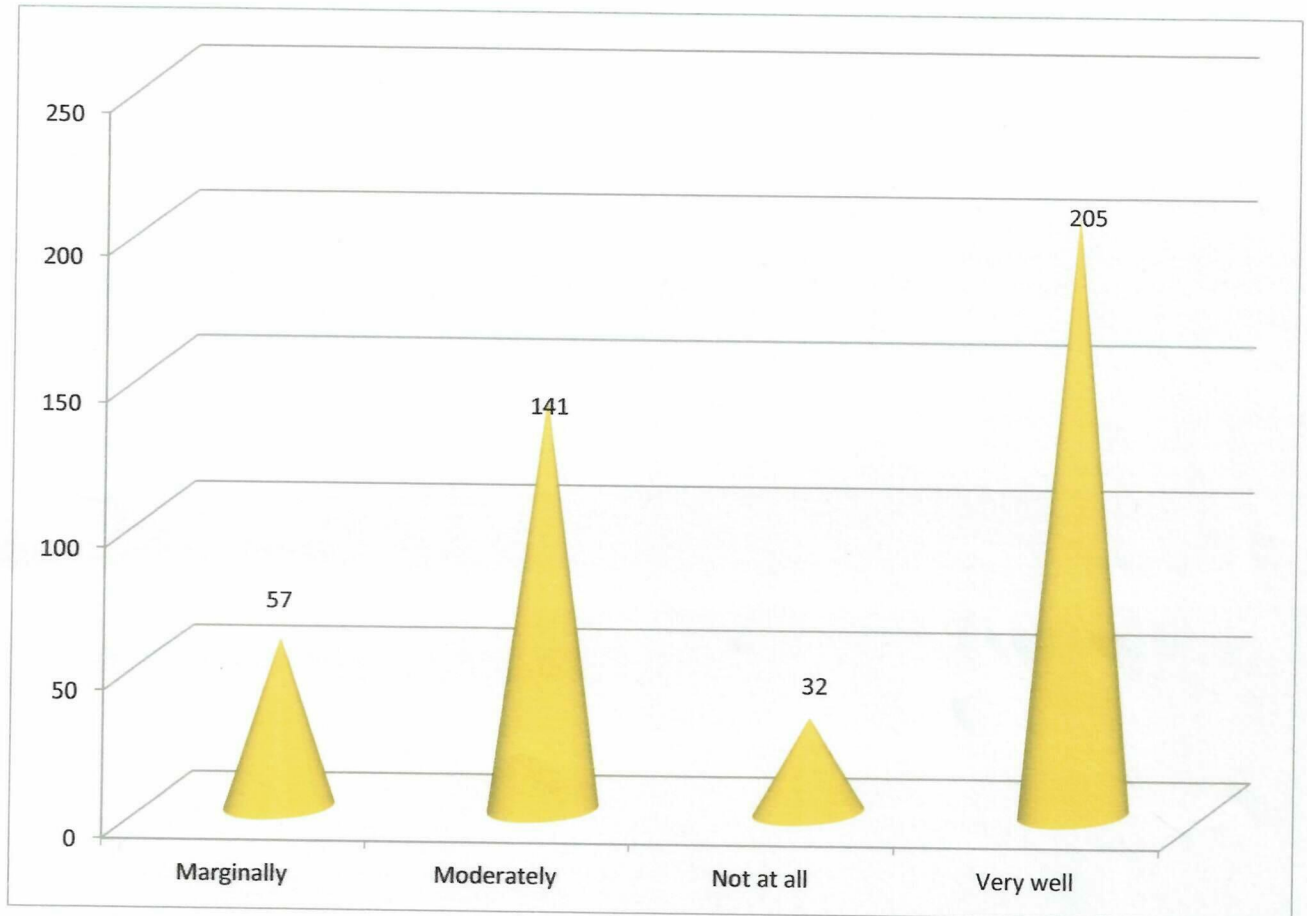

Table no 3. How do you think that you are ready for job in market after completing the course / program?

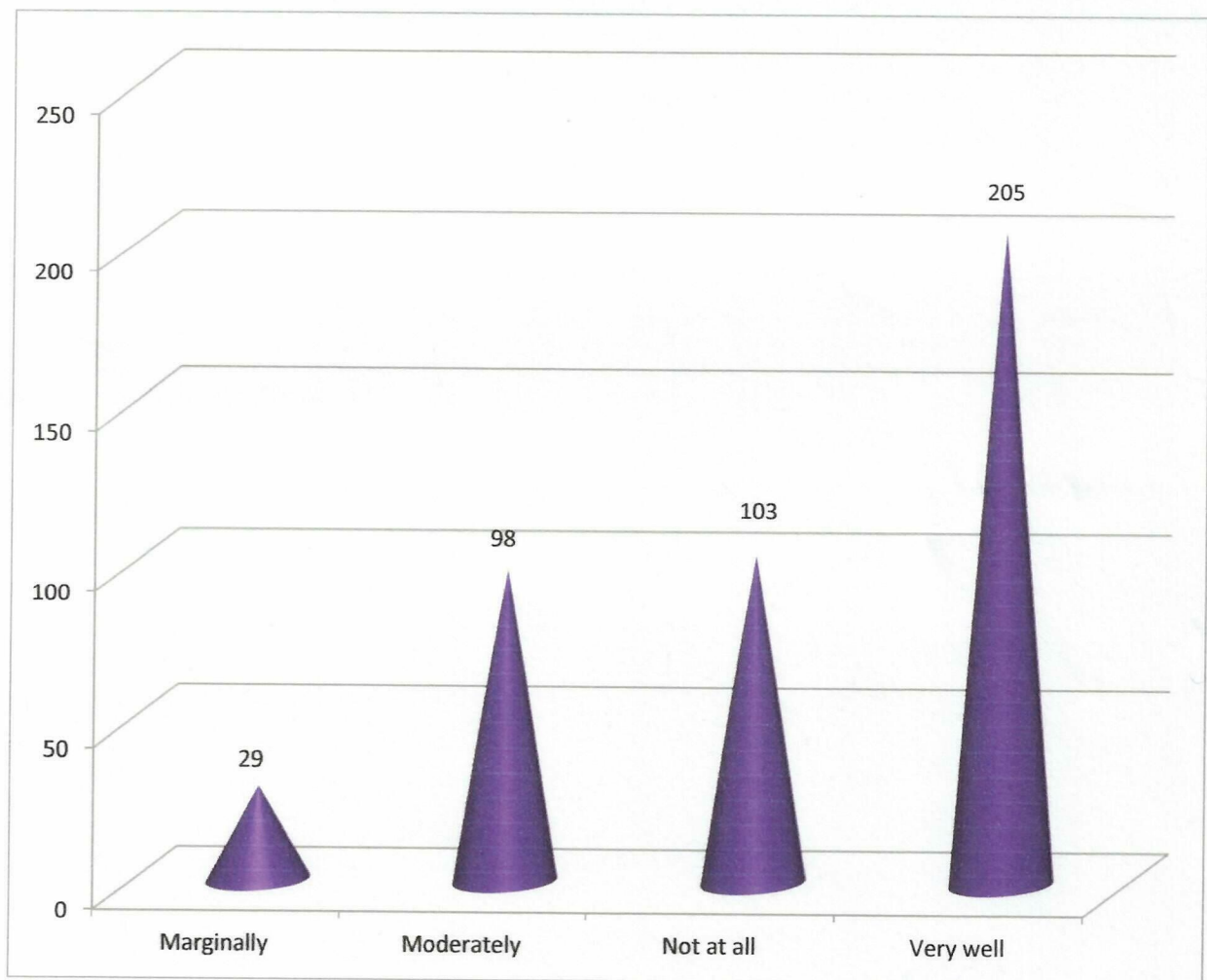

Table No 4. Do you think the curriculum teaches your employability skills?

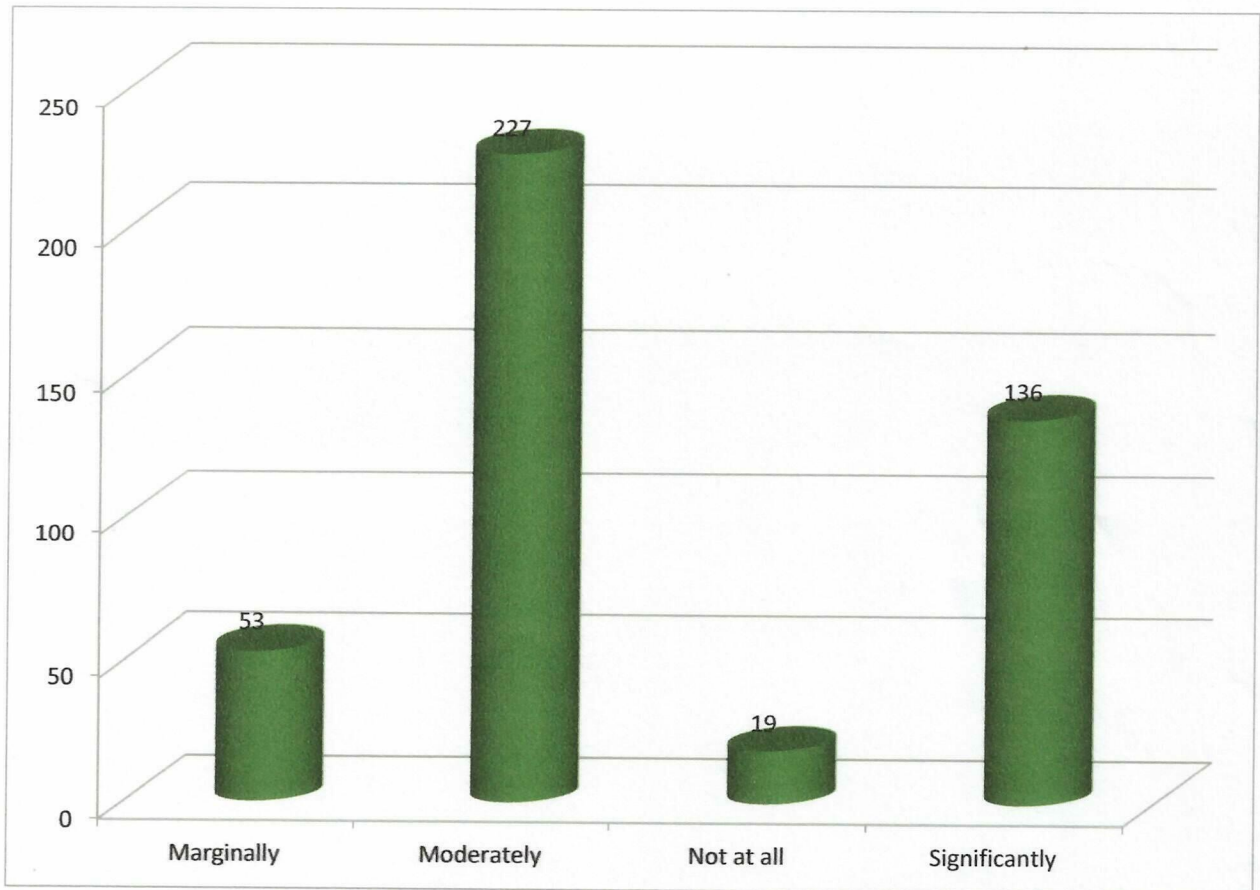

How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?

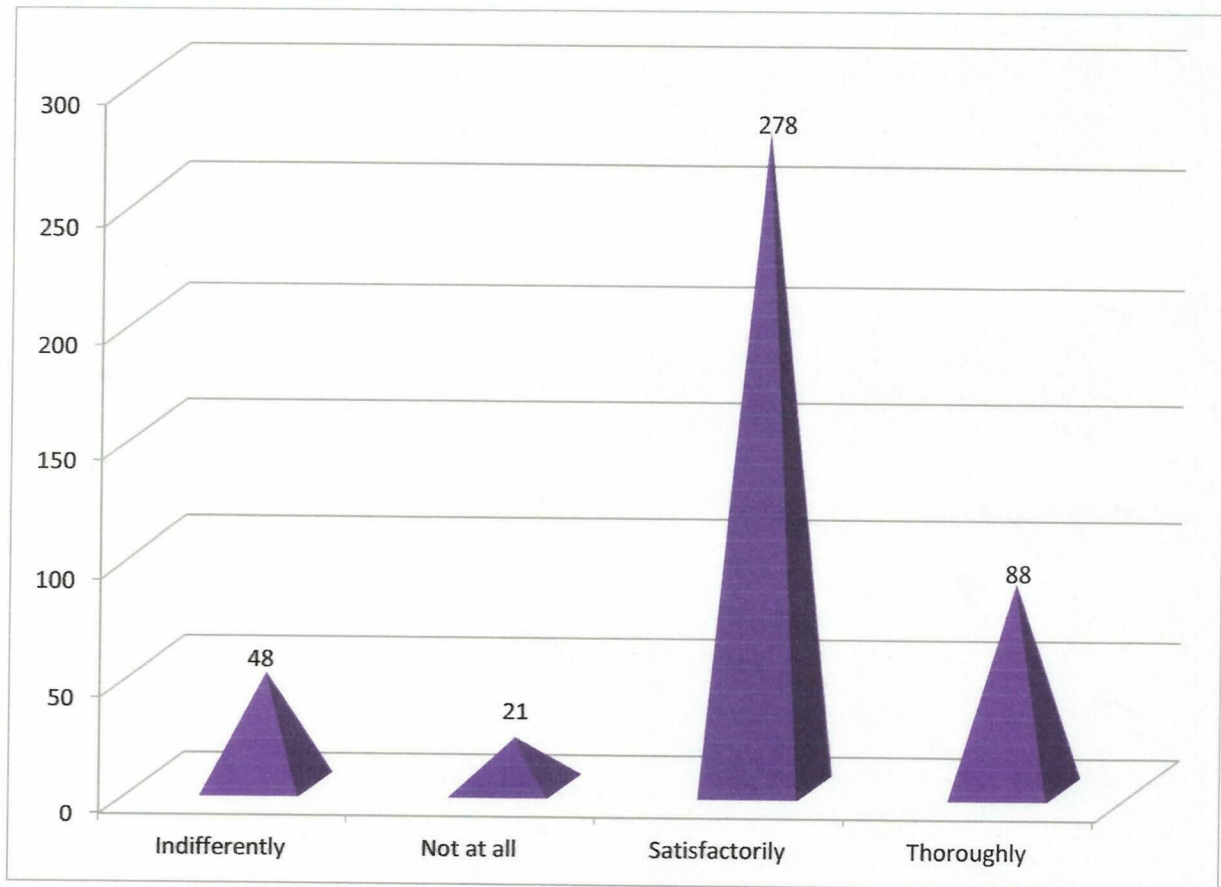

Table no 6. How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?

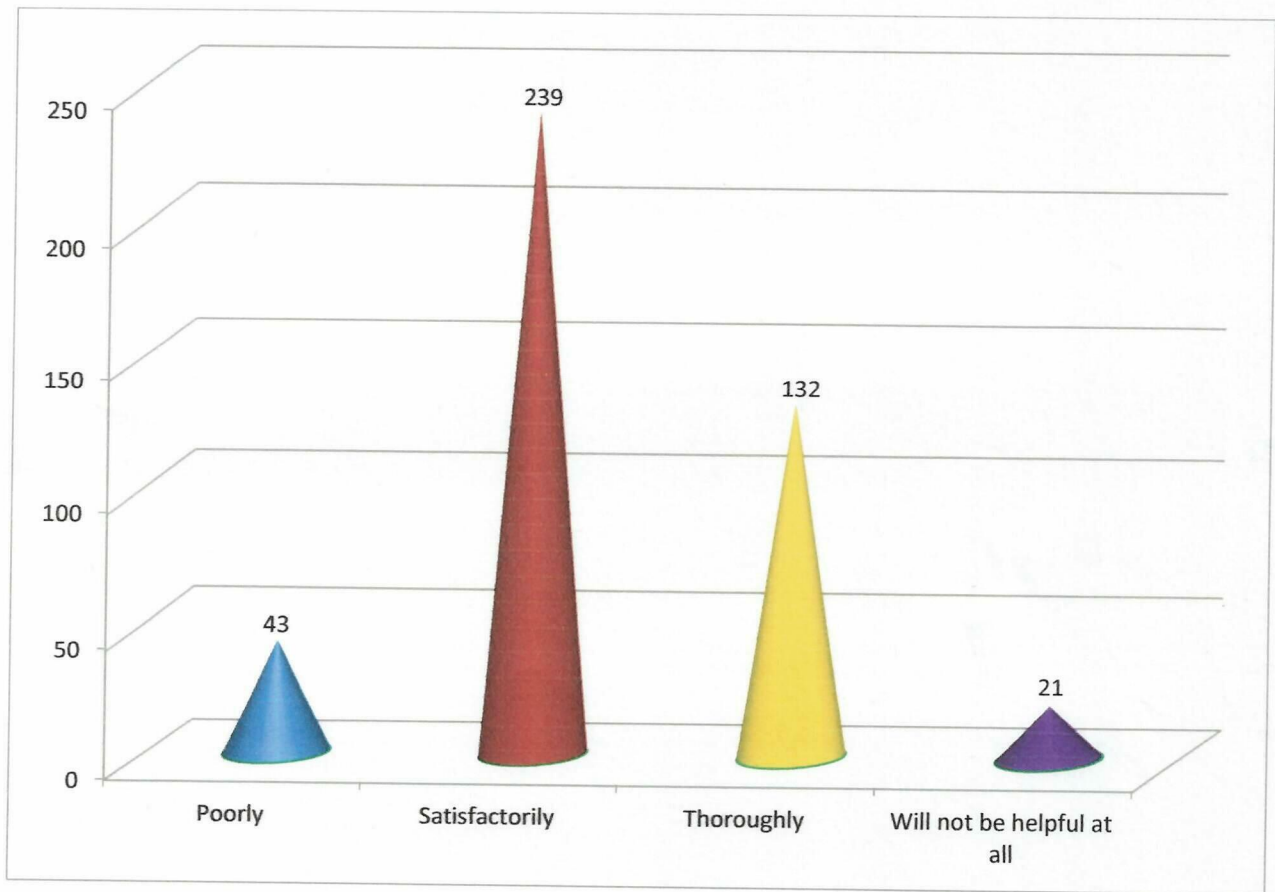

Table no 7. How do you think the practical work/field work in prescribed in the curriculum will be helpful in your future life ?.

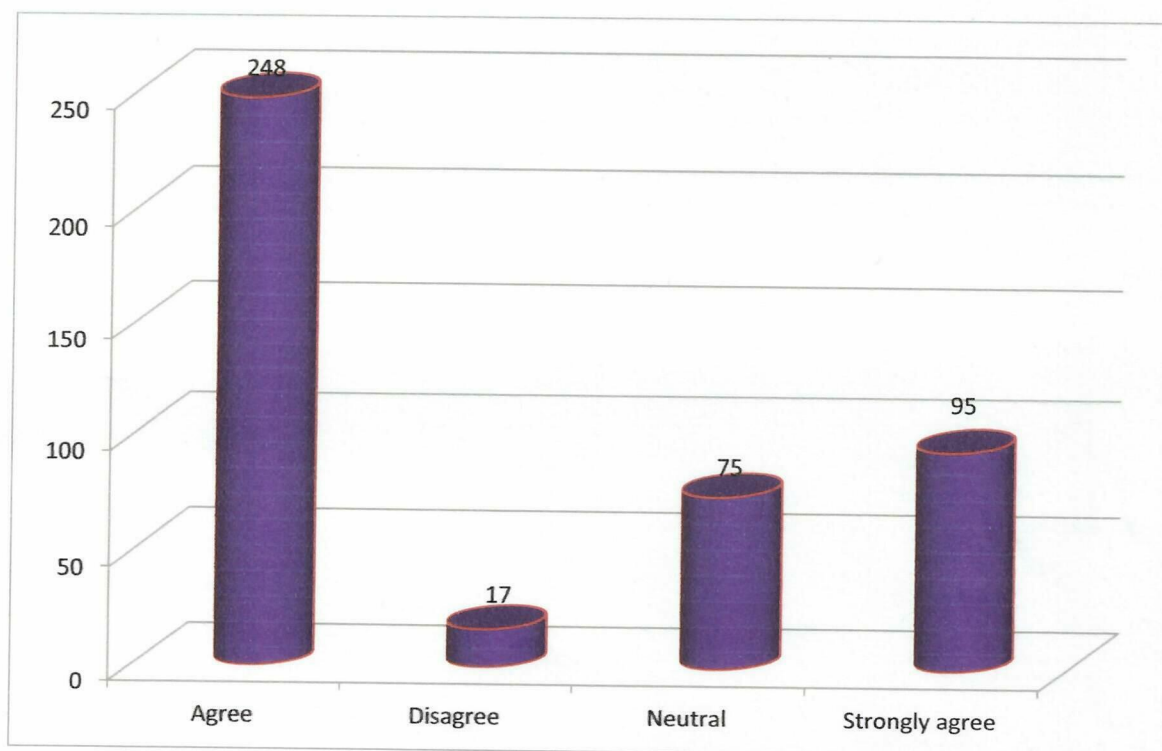

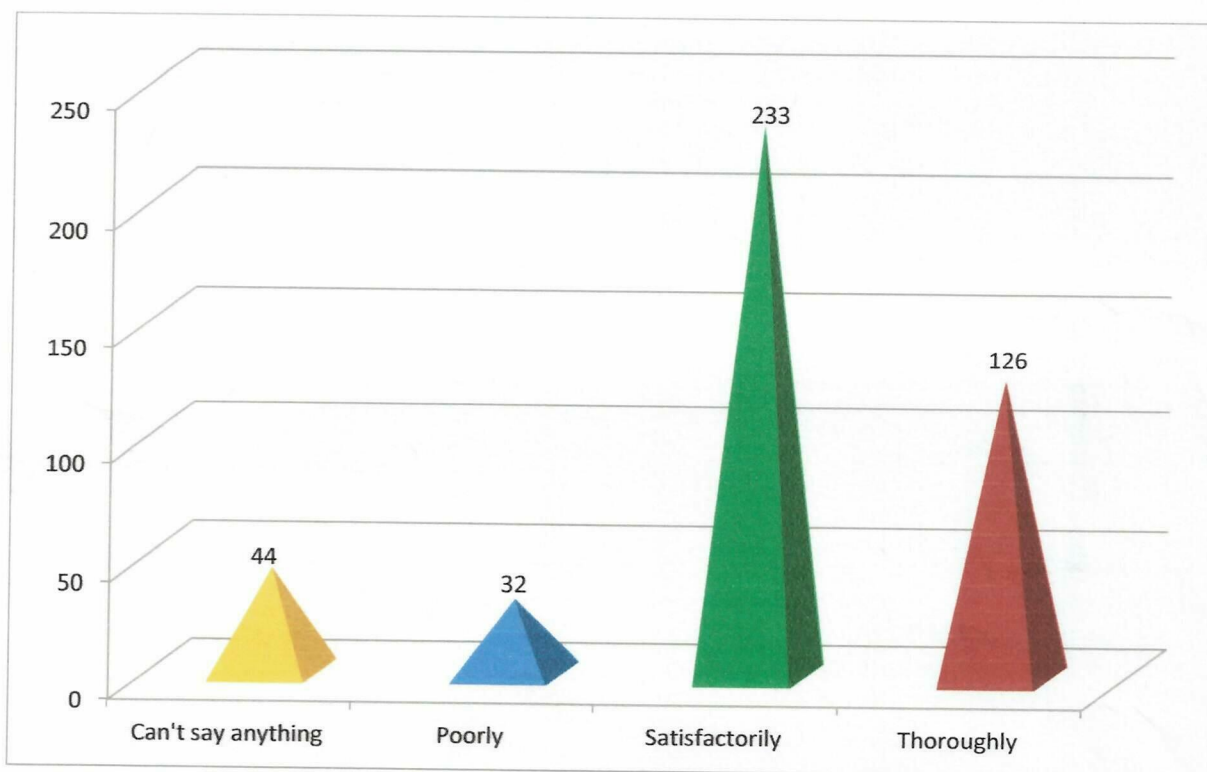

C) Discussion and conclusion on the Students Feedback on Curriculum:

1. How much do you think you understood your curriculum and its significance?

Out of 435 respondent who participated in the survey, 39% students were 85 to 100% the syllabus understood, while 44% students were 70 to 84% To 55 to 69% the syllabus understand. The remaining students like this: 15% voted for 30 to 54% and 9% students' respondent below 30% has been understand the syllabus

2. How did the syllabus match your expectations?

The feedback on the curriculum's ability to match your expectations is as follows: 147 of students believe the syllabus meets match expectations is high, 201 students believe it is moderate, 63 students believe it is topmost, 24 students believe that syllabus match your expectations are low.

3. How do you think that you are ready for job in market after completing the course / program?

When the students were asked to give an answer for this aspect, 205 students said that the ready for job in market after completing the course / program is very well Next, 141 respond with moderately, followed by 57 students with marginally, 32 with Not at all

4. Do you think the curriculum teaches your employability skills?

Out of 435 students, 205 students are opinion that curriculum teaches employability skill is very well. 98 students believe in moderately, 29 students vote to marginally and 103 students goes to fair of not fulfill employability skills

5. To how much curriculum fulfilled your learning needs?

Approximately 136 students have Significantly with the curriculum fulfilled your learning needs; 227 learners said the Moderately; 53 students rated it marginally. Remaining 19 students believe that fair to Not at all


6. How do you think the objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled?

One of the questions in the survey is regarding objectives stated about the by the university curriculum are fulfilled. The responses to this are as follows: 278 students are Satisfactorily, 88 students fair to thoroughly, 48 students are believed Indifferently, 21 students are to vote not at all.

7. How do you think the practical work/field work in prescribed in the curriculum will be helpful in your future life?.

The shares for this aspect are: 239 students are satisfactorily; 132 students are thoroughly; 43 students are fair to poorly; 21 students believe that Won't be helpful at all.
