




Q. 1. Do you think that the internal test/quiz conducted by your teachers is useful for you?




Q.2. Are You Satisfied with you Performance in the internal tests?




Q.3. Which of the Following Evaluation methods is useful for you?




Q.4. which of the following methods of teachings adopted by your teacher are useful to you?




Q.6. Do You Think newly introduces Choice Base Credit System (CBCS) Pattern is Useful?








Q.2. Are you satisfied with you performance in the internal tests?




Q.3. Which of the following evaluation methods is useful for you?





Q.4. Which of the following methods of teachings adopted by your teacher are useful to you?







Q.6. Do you think newly introduced choice base credit system (cbcs) pattern is useful?




Q.7. Are you satisfied with the marks obtained in the internal examination?






Q.8. Are you satisfied with the marks obtained in the university?

C) Discussion and conclusion on the Students Feedback on Curriculum

- 100% of the respondents agreed that internal tests and quizzes used by their teachers are useful for them.
- 100% of the respondents agreed that they are satisfied with their performance in the internal tests.
- Keeping in mind the importance of Evaluation Process based on the theory, a question was asked on the most useful method of evaluation. We received the following feedbacks i.e. 4% on Written Test, 11% & 11% on MCQ'S & Practical's respectively, whereas 74% students responded all the three methods as useful to them.




Q.5. Do you think the current University examination pattern appropriately evaluates your performance?






Q.6. Do You Think newly introduces Choice Base Credit System (CBCS) Pattern is Useful?








Q.8. Are You Satisfied with the marks obtained in the university?
